Than Whites

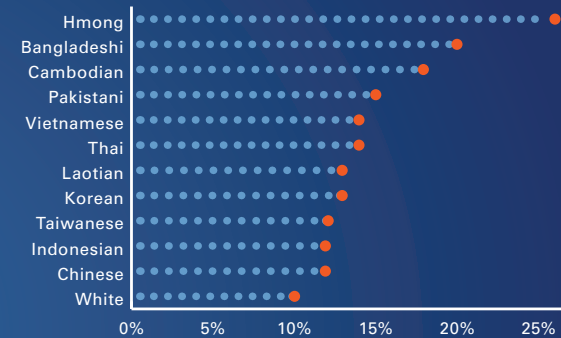

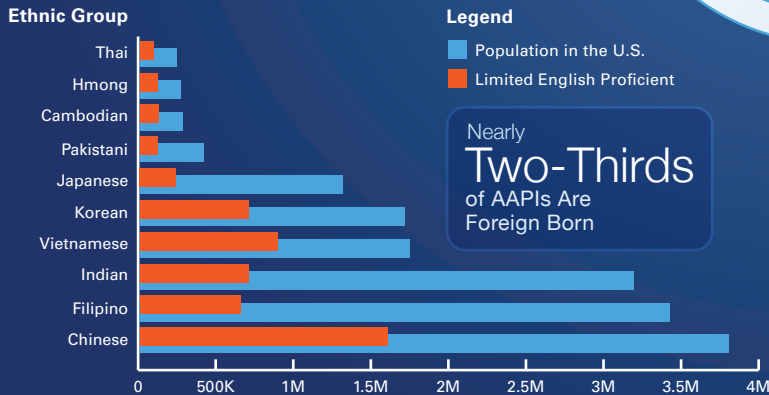
POVERTY RATE, U.S. CENSUS BUREAU 2007-2009
