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II. QUARTERLY FOIA REPORTING

On December 4, 2012, the Office of Information Policy notified OSTP and the public that beginning January 2013 it would be required to provide quarterly reporting of four key FOIA statistics to the Department of Justice that will be posted on FOIA.gov. This more frequent reporting is designed to increase accountability and enhance public awareness of OSTP's efforts in administering the FOIA.

1. Date of Posting.

OSTP's first quarterly report for Quarter 1 of Fiscal Year 2013 (covering the time period from October 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012) was posted on January 29, 2013.

2. Key Statistics Reported.

OSTP reported four key statistics for Quarter 1 of Fiscal Year 2013:

- Seven (7) FOIA requests were received during the reporting period;
- Five (5) requests were processed during the reporting period;
- One (1) request was pending beyond the statutory time period for response ("backlogged") as of December 31, 2012; and
- Of the three (3) requests that were pending from Fiscal Year 2012, three (3) have been closed during Fiscal Year 2013.
