Designation of Funding for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War

on Terrorism

Section 114(c) of the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2015 (CR), provides that the availability of funding contained in section 114(a) of the CR that is designated by the Congress for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (BBEDCA), as amended, is contingent upon the President subsequently so designating all such amounts and transmitting such designations to the Congress.

These funds for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism cover the military and civilian costs necessary to achieve U.S. national security goals in Afghanistan, the broader Middle East, and other designated conflict zones and to address other emergent crises. I recommend that you designate for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism all funding (including the rescission of funds) so designated by the Congress in Section 114(a) of the CR pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA, as outlined in the enclosed list of accounts. Upon transmittal of these designations to the Congress, these funds will be immediately available for obligation and expenditure. No further congressional action will be required for this designation. However, DOD may submit a reprogramming notice to congressional defense committees, pursuant to section 149(f), to use funds to train and equip appropriately vetted elements of the Syrian opposition and other appropriately vetted Syrian groups or individuals, as authorized in section 149.

H. J. Res. 124 also allows the Department of Defense (DOD) to accept any contributions, including assistance in-kind, from foreign governments to carry out activities as authorized by section 149. I recommend that you designate for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism any such contributions so designated by the Congress in section 149. DOD will credit any received contributions to the appropriate operation and maintenance accounts; however, the funds will not be available for obligation until a reprogramming action is submitted to the congressional defense committees.

The designation of these funds for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism allows for adjustments to the discretionary spending limits in Fiscal Year (FY) 2015, as specified in section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA. These adjustments will be reflected when the

Office of Management and Budget submits its final sequestration report for FY 2015 under section 254(f) of BBEDCA.

I have reviewed this proposed action and am satisfied it is necessary at this time. Therefore, I recommend that you make the requested funds available by signing the attached letters to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.
