Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Commission on Enhancing National Cybersecurity”**

The proposed order would create a Commission on Enhancing National Cybersecurity (Commission) that would make recommendations for enhancing cybersecurity nationwide and provide said recommendations to the President in a report within 270 days of the date of the proposed order. This executive order would have a de minimis impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include enhancing cybersecurity awareness and protections inside and outside of government, protecting privacy, and empowering Americans to take better control of their digital security. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2016. The Department of Commerce is anticipated to be impacted by this executive order.
