Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Amending Executive Order 12137”**

This executive order would delegate certain duties under the Peace Corps Act from the President to the Director of the Peace Corps. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order, following Peace Corps’ adoption of an official seal, will include more robust brand protection as the agency pursues communications and volunteer recruitment campaigns and future strategic partnerships. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2015. The agency that is anticipated to be impacted by this Executive Order is the Peace Corps.
