Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Providing an Order of Succession within the Environmental Protection Agency”**

This executive order would establish an order of succession within the Environmental Protection Agency. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order include facilitating an orderly and efficient continuity of operations in the case of multiple vacancies in certain senior management positions within the Department. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Environmental Protection Agency.
