Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“2016 Amendments to the Manual for Courts-Martial, United States”**

This executive order would provide additional rules for the military justice system, including rules to implement provisions of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Years 2014 and the Carl Levin and Howard P. “Buck” McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2015. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order include streamlining and modernizing the courts-martial process. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2016. The agency that is anticipated to be impacted by this Executive Order is the Department of Defense.
