Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Amendment to Executive Order 13673”**

The proposed order would amend Executive Order 13673 “Fair Pay and Safe Workplaces” with technical edits. This executive order would have a de minimis impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include increased economy and efficiency in Federal procurement by reducing contractor burden in meeting the requirements of Executive Order 13673 related to review of subcontractor labor violations and public disclosure of supplementary materials by contractors. Implementing this executive order would have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. Agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include those executive departments and agencies whose contractors are subject to the requirements of Executive Order 13673.
