

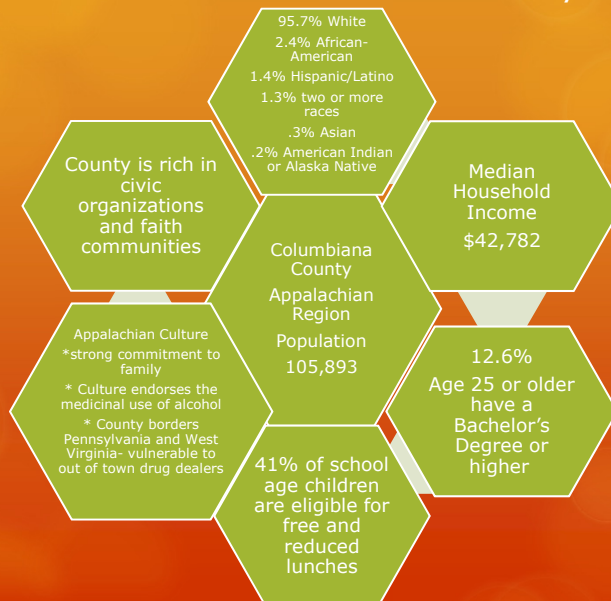

Overview of Columbiana County



Columbiana County-Wide Protocol

- ❖ Universal approach dealing with youth and families in the county regarding underage alcohol use
- ❖ 11 School districts and 1 County Career and Technical Center
- ❖ 12 Local Police Departments
 - ❖ Including Sheriff Office & Lisbon State Highway Patrol
 - ❖ November 28, 2012 County Commissioners signed a Proclamation recognizing the Coalition prevention efforts and the Protocol.
- ❖ Currently 5 area school districts have strengthened their drug and alcohol policy
- ❖ As a result of the protocol: 6% decrease in youth reporting using alcohol 3 or more times in the last 30 days or getting drunk once or more in the last 2 weeks.

Protocol Regarding Juvenile Underage Consumption

In order to promote a uniform approach to processing juveniles for underage consumption, and in the spirit of the rehabilitative goals of the juvenile court system, the following steps are recommended:

A.(1) If a juvenile is apprehended by the police for underage consumption, and the juvenile does not have a known juvenile record, then the juvenile should be referred to the local police department's juvenile division for diversion.

(2) If the local police department does not have a diversion program or the juvenile has a juvenile record, refer the case to the county prosecutor's juvenile office for review.

Protocol Regarding Juvenile Underage Consumption

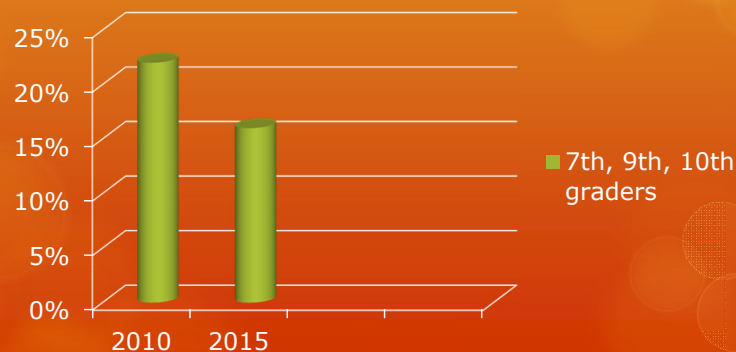
B. (1) If a juvenile is apprehended by school personnel for underage consumption, on school grounds and/or while participating in a school sanctioned event, the school should follow its district disciplinary code and procedures applying to this issue.

(2) If no such policy exists, then refer the matter to the local police department for processing as noted in section "A" above.
