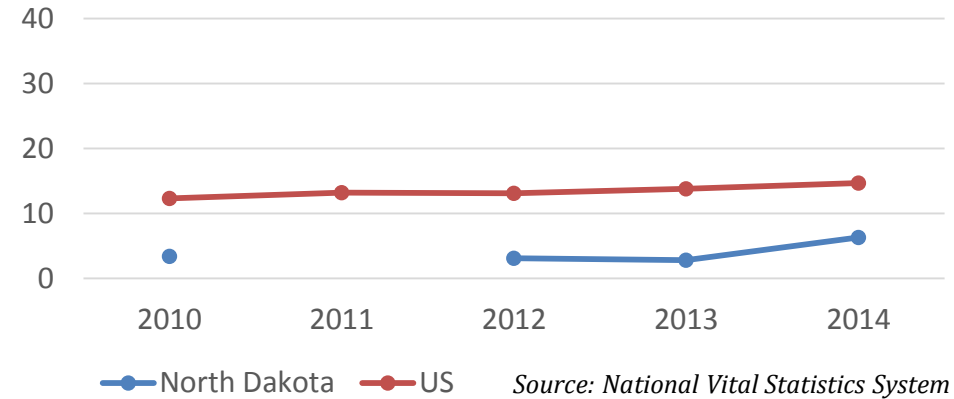

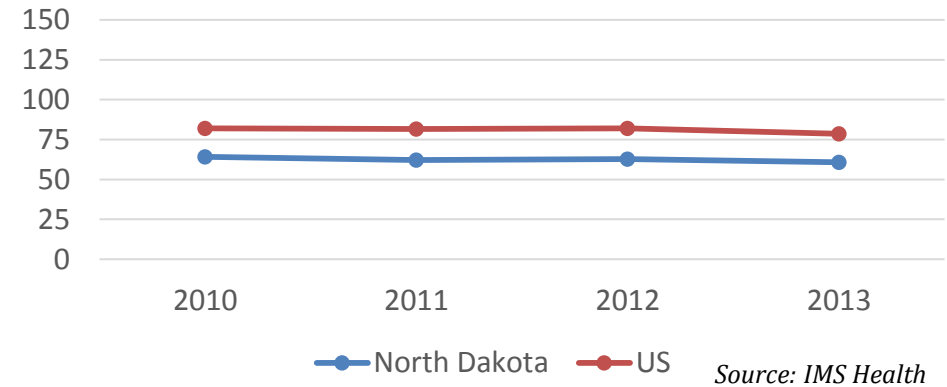
Age-Adjusted Drug Poisoning Death Rate (2014): **6.3 per 100K population**
