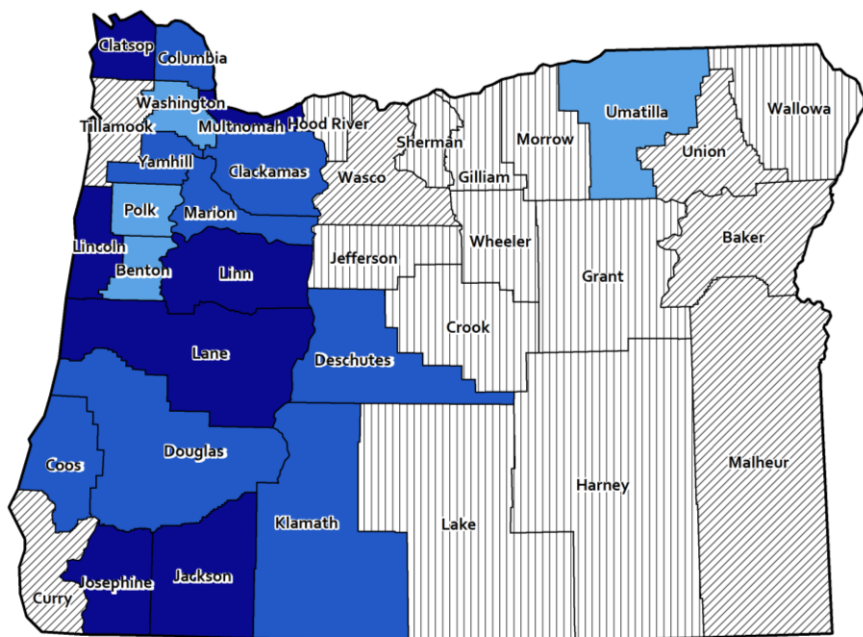

□ unreliable

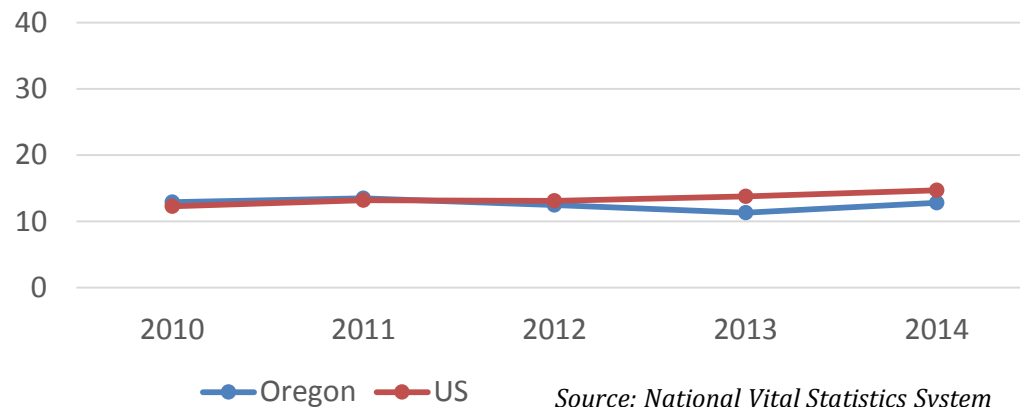

Age-Adjusted Drug Poisoning Death Rate (2014): **12.8 per 100K population**

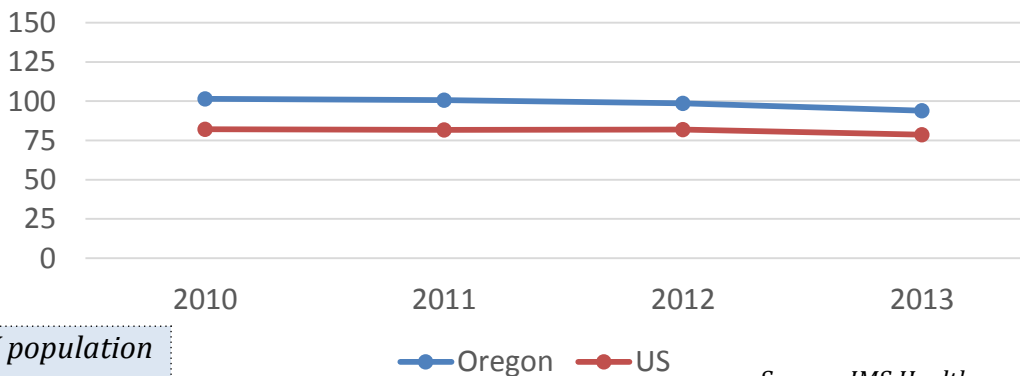
